A spokesperson from MRL Hydraulics LLC announced today the introduction of a new product for carwash hydraulic systems. ENVIRO-GREEN II® is a water glycol based hydraulic lubricant with operating performance similar to ENVIRO-BLUE®. What sets ENVIRO-GREEN II® apart from all other currently available water based carwash hydraulic lubricants is that the glycol is made from a renewable resource. The glycol is derived from a byproduct of biodiesel production.

Because it is a byproduct and is more “readily biodegradable” it can be classified as a more eco-friendly product. A further advantage of ENVIRO-GREEN II® is that the cost of the glycol is more competitive since it is not tied to the cost of petroleum, which most other glycols are made from. MRL expects that the product will be able to help offset some of the higher costs of synthetic lubricants, especially those that are petroleum based.

MRL is prepared to begin shipments of the new product beginning November 1st, 2007.
